

# How to borrow books from Russian library

The Russian library is located in Sello library in Espoo.

If you live outside the capital region of Finland, you can register as a customer of the library and borrow books and other materials in Russian and Ukrainian from there. The service is free of charge.



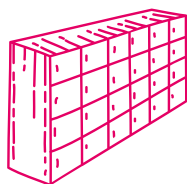
- Go to your local library and tell the library staff that you want to become a customer of the Russian library.
- You can print the **form** from the Russian library's website and fill it in beforehand.

- When you register, show the library staff your **ID**.
- Sign the form.
- The library staff will deliver the form to the Russian library.



- The Russian library will send you a **library card** number and **PIN code**.

- Now you can borrow books and other materials with your own account and PIN code.
- You can search for books and other materials in both Cyrillic and Latin characters on the website **www.helmet.fi**.



- You can choose where the books will be delivered: to a Posti **parcel locker** or to your local library.

- You will receive a **text message** when you can pick up your books.



- If you have picked up your books from the Posti parcel locker, use the same code and bag when you return the books.
- If you have picked up the books from your local library, return the books to the library in the same bag.
